However, one may participate only if the dog was entered for all 6 shows (regardless of placement).

Judging starts: Thursday and Sunday 10:00 a.m., Friday and Saturday 9:00 a.m. first show, second show starts 30 minutes after the end of the first show each day.

INDEX

PLEASE read the following pages **BEFORE** you start completing the entry forms! If you have any questions, please contact the show secretary. Please see www.asca.org for ASCA® show rules and regulations for Junior Showmanship and Conformation. The following information are for all participants, regardless if their dogs are entered in Junior Showmanship and/or Conformation and for all visitors!

Shows held by ASEA are ASCA® sanctioned events and therefore the club and all participants have to abide the rules and regulations set up by ASCA®. You as a participant agree to do so by signing the ASCA® entry form. With your signature you also agree to abide any other rules and regulations set up by the host club, so please read the following thoroughly!

Altered Conformation: See ASCA® show rules and regulations. **A copy of the ASCA® registration certificate MUST accompany all entries for dogs over 6 months of age, please add tail length information if not given on the copy!**

ASCA®-registration – entries 2-4 months and 4-6 months: If available, please include a copy of the Individual Dog Registration Application (please add tail length information). You can enter for the classes 2-4 months and 4-6 months without proof of registration, please note the tail length on the entry form then.

ASCA®-registration – entries for all classes from 6-9 months on: Please send a copy of the registration certificate with your entry, if you have applied for registration, please note on the entry form! If the tail length is not given on the copy, please add it. We want to make sure in our catalogues that NBT are not mistaken with docked dogs. If you enter a docked dog born after June 1, 1998, enclose a copy of the indication letter from the vet who did the surgery giving the reason why the dog was docked and when, full address and phone number of the vet in German or English!

Please note: Australian Shepherds 6 months or older first day of show are NOT ELIGIBLE TO START WITHOUT PROOF OF REGISTRATION **and** the fact that your dog is not yet registered does NOT mean that we will make an exception when it comes to paying the entry fee in time!

Clothing:

Please make sure that while you are in the ring showing your dog, you are not wearing clothes/caps/belts that could identify you or your dog, e. g. shirts with your kennel name or your dogs name on it, are not permissible.

Venue information:

Open from Wednesday 6.00 p.m until 8.00 p.m.

All other days from 7:30 am until the end of the exhibition

Meals available.

Tents can build up, after the show ring is placed. Please follow the instructions of the host club. The show will be held outside on grass. A grooming area and electricity is not available.

Insurance:

Each dog, enters the show ground must have a third party insurance. This also includes dogs of visitors!

Authority as householder: Your host, ASEA has the authority as householder during the show. Please note that all things that block emergency exits and/or entries or are disturbing in

any other way are to be removed immediately if we ask you to do. Dogs have to stay on lead on the whole showground!

Vaccinations:

Please check if your dog's vaccinations are current BEFORE you leave for the shows. Double check if your vet has included the date on which the vaccinations have to be refreshed in the vaccination card/vaccination certificate, some vets tend to forget that they have to include the "best before end" date! We will check the vaccination card/certificates before we hand out the start numbers. Dogs without vaccination cards/certificates and/or insufficient vaccinations are not allowed on the showground, this includes visiting dogs! All dogs have to have sufficient vaccination against rabies, vaccination must be at least 21 days old, repetition vaccination as stated by the vaccine producer.

Exception: For dogs younger than three months and therefore without rabies vaccination the following applies:

Coming from EU-member-countries they can be shown if:

- they are accompanied by their mother who is current on vaccinations (noted in her vaccination card/certificate)
- If the mother is not with them, the puppy itself has to have a vaccination card/certificate that states that the puppy was only kept at home and had no contact to wildlife animals before being brought to the showground

Catalogue:

All pre entries will be published in the show catalogue (class, number, ASCA®-registration, sire, dam, date of birth, color, breeder, owner). All details will put in the catalogue, as they were announced in the entry form. Titels or other information, not named on the entry form will not published, except by further information.

By providing the entry form, the exhibitor accept that the above named information will published.

A catalogue will be provided to each exhibitor for pre entry. Entering on day catalogue while stocks last.

Bitches in season:

Are allowed to start, please inform the ring steward that your bitch is in season; the judge might want to know.

Entry forms:

Please make sure to read the entry form before you fill it in! Don't forget your signature on the right side of the form. The person who is signing the form is responsible for the correct entry! A copy of ASCA® registration certificate MUST accompany all entries for dogs over 6 months of age, if you have applied for registration, please make a note on the entry form and include information regarding the tail length on the form if it is not given there if you enter for Conformation. You will find the newest entry form on the ASCA® website, www.asca.org

Entries will not be accepted from dogs or persons disqualified by ASCA®. Furthermore, entries will not be accepted from persons who are not in good standing with ASCA®.

Entry fees:

Have to be paid with the entry but May 1st, 2023 (crediting date) the latest! No payment reminders. Entries not paid by May 1st, 2023 will be cancelled without further notice.

Parking Cars: Space available

Parking spaces motorhomes / caravans / tents:

Spaces are available for campers, etc. for 40 euros.

Waste disposal: Please carry suitable garbage bags. Please take defective inventory with you and dispose of it at home! This also applies to the chemical toilets. Emptying on or at the show grounds is not permitted due to environmental protection regulations.

The place of disposal has to be asked for at departure. For fire protection reasons, barbecues are only allowed in designated zones!

Vendors: Please contact the secretary about reservations and fees.

Ringsteward/s: The ringsteward will check if all dogs are present for their classes, sort them in catalogue order, might give some information about the judging routine and informs the judge that the class is ready. If necessary, he/she assists in the ring Please pay attention to the ringsteward/s.

Cancellation:

If you have to cancel your start/s during or after pre entry, send a letter or e-mail to the secretary immediately. Phone calls will not be accepted.

For cancellation during the show weekend, please report to one of the ringstewards, there is a form that has to be filled in!

Docked dogs:

For "natural bobtails" there are NO requirements or restrictions as well as for merle colored dogs. The same regulations apply to docked dogs as in Germany.

Rules of conduct:

The host club is NOT responsible for poop bags or trash bags. It is your turn as an exhibitor to leave your place as clean as you have find it. Trash, as damaged chairs i.e. have to carry back and disposed at your home.

Loosening the dogs is prohibited on the show ground. Please leave the show ground with your dog for this purpose. Of course, there are always accidents. Please remove the poop immediately then.

Please do the main grooming part at home and use dirt bags at the showground.

Any kind of dirt has to be removed by the creator resp. his owner! Please clean up after yourselves before you leave!

Please keep a 1-2 m distance from the ring, make sure that no parts of your dogs (tails, legs) are in the ring, stop disturbing behavior of your dog/s immediately, don't play with or feed your dog directly at the ring.

We will have a photo corner at the showground and you are of course welcome to take pictures of the dogs in the show ring – BUT PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE SHOW RING.

All dogs (this INCLUDES puppies) have to be on leash while on the showground.

If announcements are made, please listen to them and act accordingly.

The ring entrance area is NOT for spectators but for the starters of the next class, judges and ring staff ONLY.

The sale of dogs on the showground is forbidden
