The registration point will be open on Saturday and Sunday, 7.30-8.00 a.m. and 11.30 a.m. Please pick up your competition documents within that timeframe and have the vaccination certificates of your dog/s ready to be shown. Missed runs will not be reimbursed!

All runs will be sorted by entry of payment, without this the entry is not complete!

If the shows have to be cancelled due to showside conditions, ASEA may claim part of paid entry fees to cover costs that may have been aroused since then.

To attend our shows, it is not necessary to be a member of ASCA®, ASEA or any other club but we will not accept entries from dogs or handlers disqualified from any ASCA® program or a person not in good standing with ASCA®.

Our Obedience trials are open for all breeds; this includes mixed breeds! The dog, regardless of what breed/mix it is, has to have an ASCA® **tracking number** to be eligible to compete!

INDEX

PLEASE read the following pages BEFORE you start completing the entry forms! If you have any questions, please contact the show secretary. Please see www.asca.org for ASCA® show rules and regulations for Obedience. The following information are for all participants, regardless of if their dogs are entered in Obedience and for all visitors!

Shows held by ASEA are ASCA® sanctioned events and therefore the club and all participants must abide by the rules and regulations set up by ASCA®. You as a participant agree to do so by signing the ASCA® entry form. With your signature you also agree to abide by any other rules and regulations set up by the host club, so please read the following thoroughly!

Venue information:

Open from Saturday 7.00 a.m until 6.00 p.m. to Sunday 7.00 a.m until 1 hour after the end of show.

Insurance:

Each dog enters the show ground must have a third party insurance. This also includes dogs of visitors!

Authority as householder: Your host, ASEA has the authority as householder during the show. Please note that all things that block emergency exits and/or entries or are disturbing in any other way are to be removed immediately if we ask you to do. Dogs must stay on lead on the whole showground!

Vaccinations:

Please check if your dog's vaccinations are current BEFORE you leave for the shows. Double check if your vet has included the date on which the vaccinations have to be refreshed in the vaccination card/vaccination certificate, some vets tend to forget that they have to include the "best before end" date! We will check the vaccination card/certificates before we hand out the start numbers. Dogs without vaccination cards/certificates and/or insufficient vaccinations are not allowed on the showground, this includes visiting dogs! All dogs have to have sufficient vaccination against rabies, vaccination must be at least 21 days old, repetition vaccination as stated by the vaccine producer.

Exception: For dogs younger than three months and therefore without rabies vaccination the following applies:

Coming from EU-member-countries they can be shown if:

- they are accompanied by their mother who is current on vaccinations (noted in her vaccination card/certificate)
- If the mother is not with them, the puppy itself has to have a vaccination card/certificate that states that the puppy was only kept at home and had no contact to wildlife animals before being brought to the showground

By providing the entry form, the exhibitor accepts that the above-named information will be published.

Bitches in season:

Bitches in season are **NOT** allowed to compete, must wear pants and should be crated at least 50 feet from the ring.

Entry forms:

Please make sure to read the entry form before you fill it in! Don't forget your signature on the right side of the form. The person who is signing the form is responsible for the correct entry!

A copy of ASCA® registration certificate **MUST** accompany all entries for dogs over 6 months of age. If you have applied for registration, please make a note on the entry form and include information regarding the tail length on the form if it is not given there if you enter for Conformation. You will find the newest entry form on the ASCA® website, www.asca.org.

Entry fees:

Must be paid with the entry by 07 February 2026 (crediting date) at the latest! No payment reminders. Entries not paid by 07 February 2026 will be cancelled without further notice.

Entries on day of show:

Day of show entries are possible, depending on entries received as of pre-entry closing date.

The fee will be **10,00 Euro each place**, electricity, shower, water, restrooms included.

Vendors: Please contact the secretary about reservations and fees.

Ringsteward/s: The ringsteward will check if all dogs are present for their classes, sort them in catalogue order, might give some information about the judging routine and inform the judge that the class is ready. If necessary, he/she assists in the ring. Please pay attention to the ringsteward/s.

Cancellation:

If you have to cancel your start/s during or after pre-entry, send a letter or e-mail to the secretary immediately. Phone calls will not be accepted.

For cancellation during the show weekend, please report to one of the ringstewards, there is a form that has to be filled in! **Reimbursement with doctor's/vet note only!**

Docked dogs:

Dogs whose tails have been docked after June 1, 1998 are eligible to be entered in Junior Showmanship, they are NOT eligible to be entered in other classes since May 1, 2002. It does NOT matter in which country the dog was living when it was docked. The German Animal Welfare Act, implemented in January 2021, prohibit docked dogs from competition, anyway Natural Bobtails – NBT – are eligible to compete. A written statement (in German or English!) from the vet has to be presented when entering. Please make sure that the vet's address and phone number are readable.

Behavior on the show ground:

The host club is NOT responsible for poop bags or trash bags. It is your turn as an exhibitor to leave your place as clean as you have found it. Trash, as damaged chairs i.e. have to carry back and disposed at your home.

- Please do the main grooming part at home and use dirt bags at the showground.

- Any kind of dirt has to be removed by the creator resp. his owner! Please clean up after yourselves before you leave!
- Please keep a 1-2 m distance from the ring, make sure that no parts of your dogs (tails, legs) are in the ring, stop disturbing behavior of your dog/s immediately, don't play with or feed your dog directly at the ring.
- We will have a photo corner at the show ground and you are of course welcome to take pictures of the dogs in the show ring – BUT PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE SHOW RING.
- All dogs (this INCLUDES puppies) have to be on leash while on the showground.
- If announcements are made, please listen to them and act accordingly.
- The ring entrance area is NOT for spectators but for the starters of the next class, judges and ring staff ONLY.
- The sale of dogs on the showground is forbidden
